We have seen a big increase in the number of pupils being taken out of school to go on term time holidays. We understand that during a cost of living crisis, going away in the school holidays is more difficult. However, we see the affect that absence from school has on childrens' learning and confidence.

The vast majority of holidays taken during term time result in fines being issued by the local authority, and possible prosecution, for parents and carers. Recent guidance has extended those liable to include both biological parents (regardless of contact with children) and any adult with day to day or regular care of children.

You must inform school if you plan on taking your child(ren) out of school.

Please dismount bicycles and scooters when on the school site.




