Y6 2024/25 Swimming

From 2018, schools have been required to publish how many pupils within their year 6 cohort are meeting the national curriculum requirement to swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

At Arnbrook we want all children to be proficient swimmers by the time they leave us for secondary school. Therefore, all children receive a minimum of 18 hours of swimming lessons during their time at Arnbrook.

This is achieved by Year 5 pupils going for swimming lessons, led by trained instructors, every week, during the Autumn Term.
