English	Maths
In Writing, we will be learning about the features of a diary, writing an extract linked to our class novel and exploring Newspaper recounts. Our class reading book after finishing 'Wonder' will be 'Armistice Runner' by Tom Palmer	In Maths, we will be extending our knowledge of four processes: addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. Learning about Fractions and converting units.

Science	Geography
