English	Maths
<p>In Writing, we will be developing our descriptive writing focusing on an adventure story. Followed by a poetry unit based on cinquains</p> <p>Our class reading book is “You Are A Champion” by Marcus Rashford.</p>	<p>In Maths, we will be continuing our learning of fractions including how to add and subtract them. Followed by multiplying up to 4-digit number and learning short division.</p>

Science	History

Art	PSHE
<p>This term, we will be exploring textiles and learning to weave.</p>	<p>In PSHE this half term we will be learning about Dreams and goals.</p>

PE	Computing

RE	Spanish
