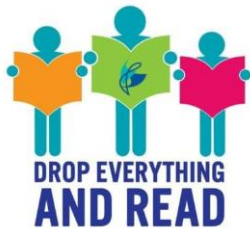




Remember to:

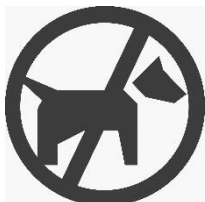
