Stay and Play

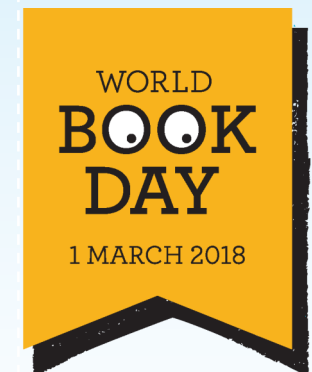

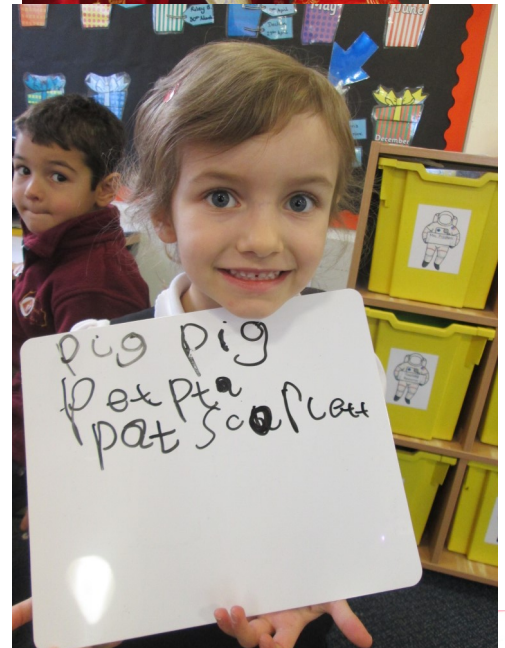
World Book Day
