Stay and Play

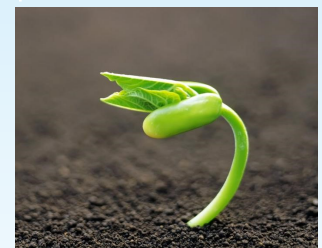
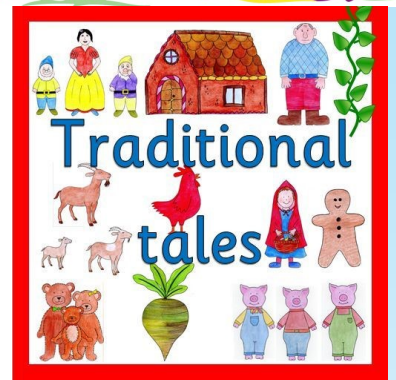
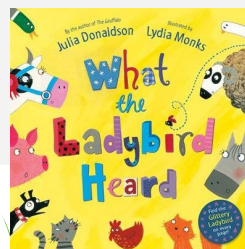
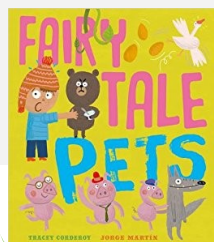
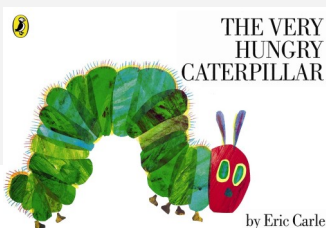
